

Assembly Instructions for Timber Pentagon Arch

Tools Required:

- Phillips Head Screwdriver and/or Screw Gun
 - Tent Pegs or Weights (for outdoor use)
 - *Recommended: 2 people for assembly and setup*
 - Product installation videos are available on the product listing on our website
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Step 1: Organize the Parts

1. Lay all **A** parts of the arch on the floor to form the general pentagon shape of the arch.
 2. Position each part so they are aligned for easy connection.
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Step 2: Assemble the Pentagon Frame

1. Use **4 bolts and barrels** to connect the first two **A** parts.
 2. Attach the next **A** part to the connected section using **4 bolts and barrels**.
 3. Repeat this process until all **A** parts are connected, forming the full pentagon shape.
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Step 3: Attach the Base Plates

1. Place the **base plates** on the inside of each side (one on the left and one on the right).
 2. Stand the arch into the slots on the base plates (*assistance may be needed for this step*).
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Step 4: Secure the Base Plates

1. On one side, use **brackets and 4 screws** to attach **part B** to the base plate.
 - Push the bracket firmly against the arch frame.
 - Offset the bracket on the opposite side slightly to prevent screws from colliding inside the timber.

2. Repeat this process on the opposite side of the arch to ensure all **4 brackets** are secured.
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Step 5: Stabilize the Arch

1. For outdoor use, secure the arch to the ground using **tent pegs** or **weights**.
 - *Important: Outdoor use is not recommended in windy conditions.*
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Additional Notes:

- This arch is recommended for **indoor use**.
- Its lightweight construction is ideal for **light floral arrangements** and fabric draping.
- Ensure all bolts, barrels, and screws are tightened securely during assembly for safety and stability.
